Southern Oregon VegFest Terms And Conditions

Please read carefully and check the agreement for every term. Submit your application after signing at the bottom.

The Vegan Promise*

- All products sold, offered, or advertised at the event must be Vegan (containing no animal products or byproducts of any kind). Products must not be tested on animals and must be free of animal derivatives such as fur, leather, silk, lanolin, gelatin, whey, lard, fish sauce, beeswax, honey, etc. Books and literature may not promote the use of any animal products or the exploitation of animals.
- All menus and signage must not depict any animal products. If you have a mix of vegan and non-vegan items on your normal menu, you must create a vegan-only menu to display at the event. If there are photos of animal products on your tent or signage, you must cover them up or bring different signage.
- You may not have non-vegan items in your food truck, booth space, or on the event premises.

Setup Responsibility*

- All vendors must be in their space by 10am or they forfeit the space and will not receive a refund. Arrival times for vendors will be staggered. Your arrival time will consist of a 15 minute window to unload your vehicle into your booth space and then move your vehicle to designated parking. Regardless of arrival times, all vendors must have their vehicles removed from the field BY 10am.
- Setup day is very busy for everyone and it is extremely important that every single vendor take responsibility for knowing the rules and setup process. An email will be sent to you with the map and setup instructions titled "Important - SO VegFest Setup Instructions"
- By committing to this event, you promise to take responsibility for reading the setup instructions, by checking the link above the week of the event.

Vendor Clean Up Agreement*

- Vendors are responsible for their own trash. Be prepared to haul your trash out.
- Food trucks and booths offering disposable products must provide their own trash bin at their booth
- Vendors must clean up 100% of waste from their booth at clean up and keep their booth space clean during the event.

No Animals Agreement

- Under no circumstances are any animals allowed on the property.
- Animals can not be left in a vehicle on property.
- Animals cannot be part of the booth ie: animals for adoption, exhibit, etc.
- Outside animals are a safety and health liability.
- If you have a Service Dog that complies with the ADA regulations that must attend, please notify us, so that we can put your booth in an area away from the sanctuary animals. Emotional Support Animals are not allowed at So VegFest.
